



Uniform Requirements – Scout/Explorer Sections

The following are the elements that complete the uniform of Scout/ Explorer Sections members of the 138th Glasgow Scout Group.

Top Half

- An official scout shirt - obtained from the Glasgow Scout Shop
- Scout Neckerchief (neckie) - Old Gold and Royal Blue (No 138) - obtained from the Glasgow Scout Shop - Neckies are only worn after a scout/explorer has been invested into the section.
- Woggle
- Official Scout Belt - Obtained from the Glasgow Scout Shop

Bottom Half

- Kilt - best obtained from online retailers - a kilt bank operates but we cannot guarantee the provision of a kilt. (ebay has a few sellers around £15-£20)
- Day Sporrans & Chain (male members only) - best obtained from online retailers
- Beige /Fawn socks obtained from the Glasgow Scout Shop (not Green or white)
- Green Flashes/Garters
- Kilt Pin - basic style available from retailers and online.
- Black Shoes - leather black shoes (plain styling or brogues - not trainers or other soft type shoes as the shoes may be used during activities that require a degree of foot protection. No other colours should feature on the shoes or laces - Shoes are readily available from a number of budget retailers.

Activity trousers are available from the Glasgow Scout Shop and may be useful, however we do not, at the moment, use these as part of uniform or as activity dress.
